



An MoU for a green renewable hydrogen facility was also signed, a first of its kind in Gujarat along with an agreement with Squawk Aviation Pvt Ltd for a flying training facility at Amreli Airport.







Mumbai's first waste to energy plant gets approved by the centre, the BMC proposed to build the plant with 600 metric tonne capacity per day at the oldest dumping ground in Deonar on 12.19 hectares area, the estimated cost of the project is around Rs. 504 crores. The upcoming Waste to Energy plant received environment clearance from the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change. The BMC has now approached the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board for its final consent, apart from the incineration of waste in dumping ground the plant will also generate 4-megawatt electricity, the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority approved the proposal with certain conditions such as the use of fly ash generated from the plant for brick manufacturing and road construction, and separate funds for implementation of the environment management plan. The SEIAA also directed BMC to set up an exclusive environment management cell.
