

• Payments banks that are promoted by corporate companies can not seek transition into a small finance bank with RBI, the Airtel Payments Bank and the Jio Payments Bank are the only 2 banks that are in function, and the rest Aditya Birla Payments Banks and others have already surrendered their licenses. The internal working group of RBI says that small finance banks can be considered for transitioning into a universal bank if they meet the minimum paid-up capital and net worth that is applicable to universal banks.
