- Active cases near 50,000 mark, covid in Karnataka has reached a whopping 50,000 cases, with Bengaluru reporting 9,020 fresh infections and two fatalities on 9th January, the Omicron cases in the state round up to 333, the positivity rate continues to be 6.33%. After Bangalore, Mysore and Udupi have also reported a concerning number of cases 398 and 340 respectively with Dakshina Kannada reporting 298 cases and 1 death. The state has made plans to impose stricter laws towards curfew offenders and have decided that all educational institute will go online and will conduct their workings online to help the future of the country stay motivated and prepare them for their various competitive exams.




