

To enhance and better protect consumer rights, the government of India amended the Legal Metrology, called the Legal Metrology Amendment Rules 2021, the Gol amended the rules through the Department of Affairs under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs. The ministry simplified the declaration of MRP and made it necessary for all pre-packed commodities to have MRP in Indian currency and declare it inclusive of all taxes. The revised rule also states that all pre-packed commodities must have a declaration of date of manufacture, the amendments will come into effect from 1st April 2022.

• The Reserve Bank of India on November 8 issued certain directions to the Babaji Date Mahila Sahakari Bank Ltd. and capped the withdrawal amount for customers at Rs. 5000. The bank prior to these directions was not allowed to write, grant, or renew any loans or make any investments without the approval of RBI, the bank was allowed to continue its banking business with restrictions till its financial position improves, the restrictions under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 will remain in force for the bank for 6 months from the closure of business on November 8, 2021.
