

• The Union Cabinet approved the continuation of Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana Gramin beyond March 2021 and also approved the funding and implementation of Ken-Betwa interlinking of the river project, chaired by Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi the Union Cabinet on December 8 approved the PMAY-G till March 2024 under the extension the target to complete the remaining 155.75 lakh houses will be achieved and the inter-linking rivers project worth Rs. 44,605 crore under the National Perspective Plan for interlinking of rivers will cover the states of UP and MP. Rs. 39,317 crores will be provided by the Central government which includes Rs. 36,290 crore as grant and Rs. 3,027 crore as loan.


• The 6 members monetary policy committee released its fifth bimonthly monetary policy statement for the financial year 2022, the 6 members team set up by the RBI met on 6th, 7th, and 8th December and released its report. RBI kept the policy rates unchanged for the 8th consecutive tie and decided to continue with an accommodative stance to mitigate COVID-19 impact, the India's real gross domestic product growth remained at 5%, the consumer price index was projected 3% in the financial year 2022 with 5.1 in 3rd quarter and 5.7 in 4th quarter.





• 'Hycore' a hypersonic weapon prototype by South Korea revealed by the Defence Ministry, the Agency for Defence Development under the Ministry of Defence unveiled a hypersonic weapon prototype called 'Hycore' the testing for the same is expected to begin in the year 2022. Hycore will be a ground-launched cruise missile with a scramjet engine and two-stage solid-fueled rocket, the missile resembles the Boeing X-51 waverider experimental hypersonic vehicle. Current India is also working on hypersonic missile technology and has successfully tested the technology demonstrator vehicle which speeds at mach 6.







• To unlock the secrets of the black hole NASA launched an X-ray space telescope, the new imaging X-ray polarimetry explorer or IXPE x-ray space telescope will help unlock the secrets of the cosmic object, the telescope was launched into orbit by the SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket, the project is in collaboration with NASA and Italian Space Agency, the objective of this project is to determine the radiation processes of the specific cosmic X-ray sources, and to explore the general relativistic and quantum effects in extreme environments.
