
Several indicators show a great rise in the exports and increasing foreign direct investment inflows into the country, the Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal states that the Indian economy is back in action, the merchandise exports during April-October this fiscal stood at \$2322 billion and total FDI during the first four months of this fiscal rose by 62%.






NALCO the national Aluminium Company Ltd. reported Q2 net surges 7-fold to a net profit at Rs. 748 crore from Rs. 107 crore last year. The strong metal sales, rose the total income from operations 51% to Rs. 3,592 crore, the company in a statement said "This is one of the strongest performances in a decade, with net profit soaring to Rs. 1,095 crore at the half-yearly stage", profit in the first half fiscal year was Rs. 124 crore.





Based on monitoring of vessels positions and data received from shipping companies, the country has imported 95.30 million tonnes of coal in April-September, the data compiled by mjunction services state that India's coal import has risen. The country's coal import rises 13% to 107 MT in April-September, in the first six months of 2021–2022, India's coal import rose by 12.6%.




