The inflation rate for the consumer food price index increased to 0.85% in October from 0.68% in September.






• Tata Projects Limited bags a \$120 million deal for a power transmission project in Bangladesh, the company secured an order on a turnkey basis from the power grid company of Bangladesh limited for a 400kV double circuit transmission line project worth \$120 million, the project is a 120 km from Barapukuria to Bogura and is to be executed in 30 months, funding for the same will be provided by Export-Import bank India under Indian Line of Credit.






• PC Mody the former chairman of the central board of direct taxes on 12 November got appointed as the new secretary-general of the upper house for a 1-year term, Mr. Mody will be a successor to PPK Ramacharyulu who was appointed weeks before on 1st September. The chairman of Rajya Sabha, M. Venkaiah Naidu appointed Mr. PC Mody, PPK Ramacharyulu is now appointed as an advisor in the Rajya Sabha secretariat for a 1-year term. PC Mody is the first IRC Officer to hold the post of secretary of Rajya Sabha.








A special mobile van with the message 'Tele-Law on Wheels' was also flagged off to empower people seeking legal advice.





• Mr. Bhupendra Patel the Chief Minister of Gujarat on 12 November launched a health care scheme 'Niramay Gujarat Yojana' to protect people over 30 years from non-communicable diseases, the scheme was launched in Palanpur city during a function and targets to cover 3 crore citizens. The main objective of this scheme is to provide free medical checkups to eligible citizens of Gujarat at the primary and community health centers and diagnose non-communicable diseases. The Gujarat cabinet also recently launched 'Atmanirbhar Gram Yatra' a program that will carry out Rs. 500 crore worth of development works in rural districts of Gujarat.




