

After its recent win in getting the three farm laws revoked, farmers are now focusing on the MSP issue, BJP MP Varun Gandhi joined the chorus on Saturday and stated 'the Stir won't end till this issue is resolved. The Samyukt Kisan Morcha a union of farmers is having a meeting this Sunday to plan their approach ahead and how they would tackle the issue of the MSP, the union also proposed a daily tractor march to parliament, the leaders of the SKM stated that they will stay put at border areas of Delhi until the centre formerly repeals these laws in parliament and also said their stir for MSP law will continue.
