

Asia's largest technology event the 24th Bangalore tech summit inaugurated by Mr. Venkaiah Naidu, the event was conducted from 17-19 november and for the first time hosted united states tech conclave, held in a hybrid format the theme of the event was "driving the next". Over 30 countries participated in the event through video conferencing and the BTS 2021 for the first time saw participation from South Africa, Vietnam and UAE.






AUKUS the trilateral security pact signed between the USA, UK and Australia, is an agreement that is made to allow all three countries share and exchange naval nuclear information. Australia on November 21 became the part of the pact and signed the deal, the country will be provided with 8 nuclear powered submarines that are capable of carrying out stealth and long range missions. The AUKUS deal will also help Australia get its hand on the artificial intelligence, quantum and many more capabilities.







The Economic advisory council on November 18 suggested that India's GDP will grow 7-7.5% in the financial year 2022-2023, the council reported to the Prime Minister and suggested that the nominal rate of growth in the financial year 2023 will be more than 11%. Construction sector is said to recover by the year 2023 and indicators such as tax collection, export growth, retail sale and power demand will also recover.
